



The Howard L Edmonds Scholarship

Application Guidelines

The Beta Sigma Boule of Sigma Pi Phi Fraternity, Springfield, MA awards an educational scholarship of \$4,000 (\$1,000 per year for four years) to a high school senior entering an accredited college or university beginning in the fall semester. Renewal of the award is conditional upon maintaining a 3.0 grade point average for full-time enrollment (12 credits or more) at the end of each academic year.

To qualify, the student must be an African American male with a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better; must graduate from a school located in Hampden or Hampshire County, Massachusetts. Applicants must complete the attached form and provide a written essay (300-500 words). An official copy of the student's high school transcript, including curriculum and grades from 9th to 12th grades, and a copy of SAT/ACT scores must also be submitted. Successful candidates must:

- Demonstrate high academic achievement**
- Be recognized as a leader in his school and community**
- Have a successful interview with the Scholarship committee**

THE APPLICATION AND ALL REQUIRED INFORMATION MUST BE RECEIVED BY March 31, 2017.

Applications received late or incomplete will not be considered. Thoroughly respond to all questions. Once your completed application is received you will be contacted by a scholarship committee member to schedule an interview with the committee.
